Our awards ceremony will be held on Saturday, March 23, with a demonstration by our Awards Judge, Allen Garns at 11:00, followed by our luncheon and awards announcements starting at 1:00. We will also celebrate our new board members as well as showcase our Artist of the Month winner. Our national show received recognition in Art of the West's Guidebook, an article in Western Art Collector, the Phippen's newsletter announcements, and Jeanne Wellin's articles in print and social media outlets in the Sedona and Prescott area.

The awards announcements will be zoomed at 1:00 on March 23. Award winners will be posted in our online catalog on Monday, March 25<sup>th</sup> and red dots will appear in the online catalog as we receive notice of sales.

Our show coincides with the Women Artists of the West's 54<sup>th</sup>Annual Exhibition, Dreamweavers, in the Marley Gallery. Several APAA members are also showing their work with the WAOW show, so be sure to visit that excellent all-woman exhibit before it closes in June.

# Minutes of the Arizona Pastel Artists Association February, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 by President Nori Thorne. Kristine Zinkgraf moved to approve the minutes of the last meeting and Christine Debrosky seconded the motion.

Show Updates: The next member show will be online secondary to conflicts with Holiday dates. Paintings do not need to be shipped. December 8, 2024 there will be a party at Arizona Artists Guild to celebrate the show opening.

For the National Show, 222 paintings were in the jury pool and 79 paintings were chosen to be hung. There will be only 1 painting per person. Nori thanked everyone who participating and also thanked people who sponsored awards. She encouraged members to participate in Artist of the Month and online shows. Shipped paintings must arrive at the Phippen by February 24. They must be shipped in an Airfloat Masterpak box with the artist sale sheet because the Phippen needs to have it for sale. An artist biography must also be included. We should also send Nori a copy of our biography. People in Northern Arizona should contact Nori Thorne if they need to have a painting transported. Those in the west valley should contact Ken Keith or Judy Wegenast, East Valley should contact Gary Binder or Peggy Orbon, far East Valley should contact Linda Curtis. Peggy will be at the Arizona Artists Guild for the next 2 weeks. Volunteers for the next National Show. Your Name and the name of the painting must be firmly attached

to your painting. The reception for the National Show will be March 23 2024 with a Demo from 10:30 - 11:30, Banquet 12 - 1, Awards Announced 1 - 3. Christine Mikesell Bidwell will take photos. Alan Garns will be the judge of awards and will be doing the demo from 10:30-11:30.

New officers were voted in unanimously and will be installed at the reception.

Artist of the month is Annie Gee for her painting "The Snowman."

There is a Plein Aire painting group that meets every Thursday in Sedona.

Dodie Ballantine reported on future programs. April 7, Alain Piccard who is nationally known for portraits, landscapes and still life paintings will do a presentation on handling edges.

May 5<sup>th</sup> will be a zoom meeting with the Artist's Challenge.

Treasurer Report: we have a bank balance of \$20,564.44.

Leila Langston reported on the plein air painting schedule.

October outing was at Mount Humphrey, November Phon D Sutton in the Tonto National Forest. Peggy Orbon won 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the Arizona Plein Aire Show for the painting she created during this outing. January was at Lost Dutchman State Park Linda Curtis hosted this event. February's meeting will be at Oracle State Park in Tucson. This will be hosted by Jude Sheldon February 21. March 16 will be held at Boyce Thompson Arboretum hosted by Alan and Sharon Frey. The Arizona Plein Air Painters will have events on weekends. Members should contact Leila if you have ideas for events. The artist's challenge for May will be a Plein Air Painting. The prize will be a Dakota gift certificate. Dodie thanked Christine Debrosky and Nori Thorne for their presentation on Plein Air painting.

Gary Binder reported that the Women Artists of the West opens March 1 and overlaps with our National show.

Two new members were recognized: Lynn Berte and Teresa Lazo.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:22.

Artists may add signature and some final highlights in the studio.

It is permissible to paint from the indoors, looking through a window to the outdoors.

Use of photographs as a reference is prohibited.

Open to members only.

Art Eligibility:

Entries must be original and completed in natural light within the last year.

They must not violate copyright laws or have been shown in a previous gallery exhibition.

Works must be in soft pastel.

Mixed media must be predominantly soft pastel with the final surface being at least 80% traditional soft pastel.

Size:

No restrictions apply.

Awards:

Three Dakota Arts gift certificates will be awarded in the amount of \$50.


APRIL 7, 1:00 ZOOM - Demo by ALAIN J. PICARD, on the topic: EDGES


